

Virtual Meal Program 2021-2022

VIRTUAL LEANER- This is for students who are 100% virtual learners along with those who are remotely learning while quarantining. Students who are 100% virtual learners can pick up 5-days-worth of meals on each Monday from 9:00 am -10:30 am from the school for which your child attends. Those who are remotely learning while quarantining, may pick up meals only for the days on quarantine.

To order meals, call 843-374-8652 to the district food service office by 3:00 pm Thursdays for Monday pick up. You may also email Valerie Mouzon at vmouzon@fsd3.org or Judy Wallace at juwallace@fsd3.org to place meal orders. When placing an order, you will need your child's name, school enrolled, ID Number and age.

If you have children that attend different locations in the district, provide the school at which each child is enrolled and which school you prefer to pick all meals at.

On-site ordering will not allowed.
